Registration Information

EVENT REGISTRATION FORM: Registration available on-line at www.mbgsc.org/training_reg.html or use a form. Both individual and troop forms are located in this book. Do not combine more than one registration/form per troop.

Please note there are two registration forms: one for troops and one for individuals. Please use the correct form. Some programs are “drop off events” and require more information than is listed on the Individual Registration form.

PARTICIPANTS ATTENDING: Fill out the forms completely and include the names of all attending. Make a copy for yourself.

CODES: Each event and session (*if applicable*) are coded. These codes must be included on Registration Form.

SESSIONS: If different sessions are available, mark preferred 1st & 2nd choices. If not marked, session will be assigned according to availability.

GRADE LEVEL: Each event shows grade-level participation.

PRICING STRUCTURE: Please notice if fee states “per girl,” etc.

Per girl - each individual girl pays. (*Safety-Wise adults free*)

Per person - everyone attending (including adults), pays.

Per couple - one girl & one adult equals a couple.

Family - every person in a family attending must pre-register and pay (unless stated that children under a specific age do not pay).

Safety-Wise - Only the required number of adults are allowed to attend the program for the number of girl participants. See pages 69 and 71 in “Safety-Wise” or Leader/Advisor Responsibility on next page. These adults pay only if fee states “per person.” They may attend at no cost if fee states “per girl.”

Tagalong - Anyone who is not a registered Girl Scout or registered for the event due to insurance issues may not participate.

Financial Assistance - Forms must be received by the first deadline of an event for consideration. This 2-part form (front & back) must be completed in full and submitted with event registration form.

OVERPAYMENT: If you overpay for an event and we must issue a refund, there will be a \$2 administrative fee charged.

CAPACITY: Some events fill before deadline. When capacity is reached, no further registrations will be accepted.

DEADLINES: Each program event has two deadlines.

Why?

The first deadline (approx. 4 weeks prior to event) is the date that a decision is made to continue with the event or to cancel if the minimum number has not been met.

- Do not hold registrations.

The event may be cancelled and would have been held if registrations had been received by the first deadline. We receive numerous calls telling us “*We were planning to attend the event with 18 girls, but you’ve cancelled it.*”

Note: It is better to register 10 girls that you are sure about and add the additional girls at a later date because your 10 girls might have made the minimum number required.

Why do we sometimes cancel the event before the last deadline? We cancel a program in order to defray any additional costs associated with the program if we do not have the minimum number of registrants. If we cancel, we will lose facility deposits and possibly supply expenses and staff planning time. Programs are not meant to make money, but we try not to lose any more than we have to.

- Registrations will be accepted at a higher fee if space is available and if the event has not been cancelled. Please note the final registration closing date (*approx. two weeks prior to event*).
- Enclose the correct amount of money indicated based on when the registration will be received by the Council.

INCOMPLETE REGISTRATIONS: Forms with incomplete information, inaccurate fees, or those received after deadline will be returned. No registrations will be processed after the final deadline.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Mail: Must be "postmarked" by 6pm ET by deadline date and include check, money order, or credit card info.

Fax: Must be "faxed" in by 6pm ET by deadline date giving credit card info.

Hand Delivered: Must be "delivered" before 6pm ET by deadline with payment.

Telephone: None accepted unless indicated.



- Provide only the required number of registered Girl Scout adults for supervision as stated in **Safety-Wise**. Space is limited to registered Girl Scouts and the appropriate number of adults (*unless otherwise stated*).

2 adults for every 6 **Daisies (Grade K-1)**

(plus 1 adult for each additional 4 Daisies)

2 adults for every 12 **Brownies (Grades 2-3)**

(plus 1 adult for each additional 6 Brownies)

2 adults for every 20 **Juniors (Grades 4-5)**

(plus 1 adult for each additional 10 Juniors)

2 adults for every 20 **Cadettes (Grades 6-8)**

(plus 1 adult for each additional 10 girls)

2 adults for every 24 **Seniors (Grades 9-10)**

(plus 1 adult for each additional 12 girls)

2 adults for every 24 **Ambassadors (Grades 11-12)**

(plus 1 adult for each additional 12 girls)

- **Tagalongs (unregistered children) will not be accommodated at Council events, unless indicated, due to council insurance liability.**

- Collect and return all fees and Cookie Dough by deadline. Financial Assistance forms must be completed and returned by *first* deadline.

- Collect all parental permission slips.

- Advise parents and girls that events are open to them even if troop is not attending.

- Carry medical releases to events.

Confirmations

- Only registered participants will be notified of cancellations or changes. If you do not receive a confirmation one week prior to event, please contact Program Services Dept.
- If registering online and paying with a check (instead of a credit card), your registration is not confirmed until payment is received in this office.
- If an event does not have enough participants, it may be necessary to cancel. Don't delay in sending in your registration.
- Sometimes you forget to inform us if you're planning on attending an event (*especially those with no fees required*); therefore, we cannot notify you of cancellations or changes if we don't know you're coming.



Cancellation Policy

- If we cancel, all registration fees will be returned in full.
- If a participant cancels, a written request must be received by the Council office by first deadline to receive a refund (less administrative fee*).
- In case of illness or family emergency, refunds (less administrative fee*) are made only when a written request, which includes a physician's statement, if applicable, is received by the Council no later than two weeks after the event.

*10% of the fee paid or a minimum of \$2 per person will be retained as an administrative fee. On large events/trips, the deposit plus 10% and \$2 administrative fee will be charged.

Directions to Council Events (Southern Region)



Southern Region Service Center

From downtown Chattanooga, go north on Highway 27 and take the Dayton Boulevard exit. Go approximately three blocks. We are located on the right.

From Highway 27 going south toward Chattanooga, take the Signal Mountain Blvd. exit. Turn left onto Signal Mountain Blvd. At traffic light, turn left onto Dayton Blvd. and go

approximately two blocks (.9 miles). Located on the

Bluewater Grille - From I-75S, take I-24W towards downtown Chattanooga. Remain on 24 West and merge onto 27 North. Take exit 1C onto 4th Street. Turn left onto Broad Street. Go 2 blocks and Blue Water Grille will be on the right. (224 Broad Street, Chattanooga, TN 37402)

Brainerd Crossroads - From I-75, take I-24 towards downtown Chattanooga. Take Exit 183-A, Germantown Road/Belvoir Avenue. Merge onto North Terrace. Turn right at Belvoir Avenue. Turn right at Austin Street. Brainerd Crossroads will be the large building on the right. (4011 Austin Street, Chattanooga, TN 37411)

Chatt. National Cemetery - From ML King Blvd., turn right onto Holtzclaw, turn right into entrance & bear left toward pavilion by lake. (1200 Bailey Ave., Chattanooga, TN 37404)

Chattanooga State - From I-75, take Hwy. 153 North approx. 7 miles to Amnicola Highway. Turn onto Amnicola Hwy. Chatt. St. is approx. 2 miles on the right. (4501 Amnicola Hwy., Chattanooga, TN 37406)

Chattanooga Theatre Centre - From I-75S, take I-24W towards downtown Chattanooga. Remain on 24 West and merge onto 27 North. Take exit 1C to 4th Street. Turn left at Market Street. Cross Market Street Bridge and turn right onto Frazier Avenue. Turn right at Tremont Street like you are going to Coolidge Park. Theatre Center will be on your left. (400 River Street, Chattanooga, TN 37405)

Girls Preparatory School (GPS) - From Knoxville: Take I - 75 South to Chattanooga. From Atlanta: Take I - 75 North to Chattanooga.

Take I - 24 West, then Hwy 27 to downtown Chattanooga. Take 4th Street Exit. At the sixth traffic light turn left onto Georgia Avenue and cross the Veterans Bridge. Take the first right after the bridge onto Island Avenue. Stay on Island Avenue until you see the visitor parking area (205 Island Ave., Chattanooga, TN 37405)

Hamilton Place Mall - From I-75, take Exit 5 at Shallowford Rd.

Hiwassee River (Raft Race) - Get off I-75 at Cleveland Exit #20. Take a right which puts you on Hwy. 60 By-Pass. (From Knoxville, take Cleveland Exit #25 which is Hwy. 60 By-Pass. Take a right, toward Cleveland.) Take a right on Hwy. 64 (Ocoee Exit-East). Take the exit for Hwy. 411 & go north toward Benton. Go through Benton & turn right toward Reliance on Route 30. After passing the Texaco Station in Reliance, take next left which will lead you to Hiwassee River Outfitters. The railroad truss is starting point. (155 Ellis Creek Road, Reliance, TN 37369)

Hunter Museum of American Art - From Atlanta: drive I-75 North to I-24 West. (From Knoxville: drive I-75 South to I-24 West) Take I-24 to downtown Chattanooga. Take U.S. Highway 27 North to Exit 1C right on 4th Street. Turn left on High Street. The Hunter Museum parking lot is on the right at the end of High Street. (10 Bluff View, Chattanooga, TN 37403)

Jones Memorial United Methodist Church - From I-24, take Exit 181-A (US 41-South) toward East Ridge. Take slight right and follow road through the Bachman Tunnel. Follow Ringgold Road. Church is on left. (4131 Ringgold Rd., East Ridge, TN 37412)

Lake Winnie - From I-75S toward Atlanta, take exit 353 for GA-146 toward Ft. Oglethorpe/Rossville. Turn right at Cloud Springs Rd./GA-146. Turn right at Lakeview Dr. From I-24, take the Moore Rd. exit south toward E. Ridge. Turn left at Ringgold Rd. Turn right at McBrien Rd. Road ends at Lake Winnie. (1730 Lakeview Dr., Rossville, GA 30741)

Loose Cannon Art & Events - From I-75, take I-24 towards downtown Chattanooga. Take Exit 178 onto South Market Street. Turn right at East Main Street. Turn right on Adams Street. Turn right onto Rossville Avenue. The building will be on your left. (1800 Rossville Ave., Chattanooga, TN 37408)

Museum Center at Five Points (Cleveland) - From I-75 North, take Exit 25 and proceed to Hwy. 11 exit ramp. Turn left onto Hwy. 11 (S. Lee Hwy.) and proceed north to Inman Street. Turn right. The Museum Center is located on the right at the 4th traffic light. Turn right into parking lot. From I-75S, take a right at the end of the ramp onto Hwy. 60 (25th Street). Proceed east to Ocoee Street (5th light). Turn right and proceed to Inman Street. Turn left onto Inman. The Museum Center will be on the right at the third light. (200 Inman St. East, Cleveland, TN 37311)

Northgate CDM Science Theater - From Knoxville, take I-75 South (Exit 4) to TN-153N. (From Georgia, go North on I-75 to TN-153N.) Cross over Chickamauga Dam. Northgate Mall is 3 traffic lights after the dam on the right. Science Theatre is located at the rear of Northgate Mall between the Belk store and JC Penney. (18 Northgate Park, Chattanooga, TN 37415)

Notre Dame High School - From I-24, take the Germantown Rd. Exit. Go north to Brainerd Rd. & turn left. Stay in right lane as you exit tunnel (don't go over viaduct). Turn right at Glenwood Drive. Turn right at Vermont Ave. (by Pilgrim Congregation Church). Stay on Vermont Ave. (school on the left).

Directions continued

Red Bank United Methodist Church - From Downtown Chattanooga, go north on Hwy. 27 and take the Dayton Blvd. exit. Continue on Dayton Blvd. going towards Red Bank. Turn right onto E. Leawood. Church will be on the left. From Hwy. 27 going south toward Chattanooga, take the Morrison Springs exit. Turn left onto Morrison Springs and continue until it dead ends at traffic light on Dayton Blvd. Turn right at light. Turn left onto E. Leawood and church will be on left. (3800 Dayton Blvd., Chattanooga, TN 37415)

Southeast Bank Community Room (Athens) - From I-75N, take Exit 49 toward Athens/Decatur. Turn right onto Decatur Pike (TN-30 E/David W. Lillard Memorial Hwy.). Continue on Decatur Pike for approx. 1.5 miles. Turn right onto Congress Parkway. The bank is about 0.5 miles on the right. Enter the community room through the back of the bank. (1878 S. Congress Pkwy., Athens, TN 37303)

Tivoli Theatre - From I-75S, take I-24W towards downtown Chattanooga. Remain on 24 West and merge onto 27 North. Take exit 1A ML King Blvd. Turn right onto ML King. Turn left at Broad Street. Tivoli Theatre will be on the left hand side of the street. (709 Broad Street, Chattanooga, TN 37402)

Urban Rocks Climbing Gym - From Knoxville, take I-75 South (Exit 4) to TN-153N. (From Georgia, go North on I-75 to TN-153N.) Take Amnicola Highway exit. Go past Chattanooga State. Appling Street will be one block past the Fire Training Center on the left (between two gas stations). (1007 Appling Street, Chattanooga, TN 37406)



Camp Adahi

(125 Camp Adahi Road, Cloudland, GA 30731)

Directions from Chattanooga: From I-24 West, take 27N and then take Exit 178 (Lookout Mtn./Market St. South). Follow Lookout Mtn. South signs to traffic light at Broad Street, turn left... -OR- From Hwy. 27, go north toward Atlanta/Knoxville. Exit at Lookout Mtn. South. At intersection, turn right and continue toward Broad St. and at traffic light turn left...

... stay on Broad until you come to traffic light directing you to Incline Railway (TN Ave./Hwy. 17). Turn left at light and continue on TN Ave. until it splits to the right and becomes St. Elmo Ave. (Hwy. 17). As you enter Georgia, St. Elmo Ave. (Hwy. 17) becomes Hwy. 193. Follow Hwy. 193 out to the intersection with Hwy. 136. Turn right onto Hwy. 136 and go 4.5 miles up the mountain. At Hwy. 157 intersection, turn left and travel 12.3 miles. Camp Adahi is on the right.

Alternate route from Chattanooga/Nashville area: Take I-24 to Georgia I-59 toward Birmingham. Take Exit 11, for Trenton. Turn left at the traffic light, and go two more traffic lights to Hwy. 11. At Hwy. 11, turn right and go one block to Hwy. 136 (follow sign to Cloudland Canyon). At Hwy. 136, turn left and travel 9.4 miles to Hwy. 157. Turn right at Hwy. 157 and travel 12.3 miles. Camp Adahi is on the right.

From I-75: Take Exit 306, Hwy. 140 (Adairsville) toward Summerville. Pick up 27 North in Armuchee to Summerville & continue on 48 West through Menlo to Cloudland. Turn right onto Hwy. 157. Camp Adahi will be on the left, approx. 11 miles.

From I-59 North: Take Exit 231, Valley Head-Mentone, travel toward Valley Head and Mentone on Hwy. 117. When you reach the Georgia State Line, Hwy. 117 becomes Hwy. 48. At the intersection and caution light, turn left onto Hwy. 157. Adahi is approx. 11 miles on the left.
